

Access to Sliding Doors in ICU Wards is Now a Simple Operation

The latest hardware set from Adams Rite was assembled specifically to address the easy access needed for sliding doors in hospital ICU wards. This device meets code requirements for self latching door mechanisms on ICU doors. A pair of handles from either side of the door stile activate an Adams Rite hookbolt deadlatch.

The handles are positioned parallel with the stile to provide for faster latching or unlatching of the door. With one natural motion, hospital staff can open and close doors easily and quickly.

The 4570 Latch Operator utilizes the Adams Rite 5017 or MS1847 Series of deadlatches, known for their durability and strength-in-small-packages. The handles can be installed either up or down to suit the preference of the user. Rugged construction ensures dependable performance, with a high-wear spring to return the handles to position after use.

Installation is a simple operation, too. All pieces are easy to install and include solid-contact activators to engage the deadlatch on either side.

For hospital ICU wards or other applications that require quick access, the new 4570 Latch Operator provides a cure.
